⚙️ Hasan in a nutshell Introduction

There are three major pillars in my career:

- - SAP MM and P2P processes in Industry, Chemicals and Retail

As SAP MM consultant I have as well hands on experience in Kernel Development and Roll Outs (Work Shops, Blueprinting, Design, Realization, Testing, Data Conversion, Go Live Support, Application Support, Interfaces, Customizing, etc) as also process experience in analyzing and improving P2P processes as part of CPO project.

- - SAP Security and Authorizations
I can do almost everything in SAP Security and Authorizations and I have quite a lot experience in Internal Control and SOX.
- - Team Management and Project Management
In several projects I was having several coordinating roles such as Team Lead, Roll Out Coordinator, Kernel Delivery Manger or Project Manager. In these roles I have got experience in Team Management and Project Management.

Almost all my projects have taken place in complex international environments. And more complexity means more fun. A day without solving complex problems is a lost day. This is actually the best description of my motivation. And my ambition is to develop as a consultant / project manager, mainly to distinguishing myself through professionalism, quality, added value to the business of my customers and excellent service.

In Prometheus Project, we have implemented Industry Solution for Retail by toom Baumarkt, a daughter of REWE Concern in Köln, Germany. After we have Implemented this Solution in about 300 Stores, we are now optimizing a Solution and in parallel we are developing existing Solution for Partners and Franchisers. After that we will be implementing it in additional 60-80 Stores.

Baumarkt. After Pilot go Live we have developed Release R1.1 (containing some enhancements) in parallel with mass Roll Outs, to bring about 300 Stores across Germany on the new System.

RI-Solution in Munich is a Consultancy Company owned by BayWa and RWA which are indeed two biggest customers of RI-Solution. For this project, I was hired by RI- Solution to design, realize and implement new Authorization Concept for one of the important BayWa's divisions Agrar. After this Projekt was so successful BayWa wanted us to do the same for second division: Baustoffe. The new concept exists of new set of

Authorization Roles which are fully in line with SoD matrix and Control procedures (as part of Internal Control Framework) which I have designed for this project.

Team Lead of Security and Authorizations Development Team

In Gates project, in which all authorizations for BASF were redesigned, my role was: Functional Team Lead of Development Team. The project is affecting about 60000 users, 14 major SAP systems and about 3000 Template Roles in SAP.

The very high level design was done by Deloitte and the detailed design and the development (of as well required tools as of all authorization roles) by Tech Mahindra. In my role of Functional Team Lead of Development Team, I was taking care that all development activities are being done in proper way (in terms of process but also in terms of content). In this role I was the functional bridge between business (Functional Work Streams of BASF), designer (Deloitte) and Development Team (mostly off shore delivery by Tech Mahindra). At the same time I was translating functional solutions to technical solutions in the system and taking care for implementation of it.

The whole new Authorization Concept as well all developed roles were fully in line with SoX and SoD rules as defined by BASF. In order to deliver that, we also have developed several new SoD reports or have redesigned the old ones.

Yeoman project, designed by Capgemini to bring Yamanouchi in whole Europe to SAP, was having about 2 months to go live when people have discovered that there is no (anything of) Authorization Concept at all. So, Capgemini asked me to set up authorization concept, create all roles as defined, prepare all tools and documents required for international roll outs in a very short notice.

My activities in this period were:

- design the Authorization Concept of Yamanouch Europe,
- create the authorization roles as defined in concept,
- define SOD conflicts based on internal control procedures,
- set up the authorizations for new sites,
- create a roll out kit
